

Registration Forms

The convention registration can be accomplished by three different modes:

First – A mail in version completed on an interactive online form: This mode is preferred for its accuracy.

Second - A convenient online form to allow you to use a credit card for payment. **(NOTE: There is a 3% fee is added to each item to cover the credit card processing costs on this form.)**

Third – A mail in form completed by hand.

FIRST -- Mail In Form completed on computer (desk top or laptop): (Form does not work on smart phone or tablet)

This method is preferred, because your information will be legible and calculations will be done automatically, eliminating the possibility of misspelled words or mathematical errors. The form is programmed to work with a recent version of Adobe Reader. Please read the following instructions carefully before starting:

- Click the **Start Mail in Form - Computer** Button Below.
- Place the cursor on the Last Name line on the Registration Form.
- Type your name and press the Tab key to advance to the next field.
- Continue inputting and tabbing to complete the form.
- To make corrections/changes, use your mouse to go to the field you want to change. Highlight to delete, or type over to make the correction.
- When complete, click the Print button at the bottom of the form.

SECOND – Online Form for use with Credit Card

This form is processed through CTCI's Constant Contact and can be paid by credit card or Pay Pal. You do not have to have a Pay Pal account to use it. Please read the instructions here before you go online; and carefully follow the instructions on the online material to minimize/eliminate questions and confusion.

- Click the **START On Line Credit Card Form** Button Below.
- This form treats any advance reservation deposit as a "Promo Code" Please read the instructions carefully to get credit for your deposit and be sure to push the "APPLY" button.
- IF you need to make a correction to an entry or miss an entry, use your mouse to move to the missed or incorrect location. **NOTE: DO NOT USE THE BACKSPACE KEY TO MODIFY INPUTS.**
- After completing the form you will be directed to make your payment. Once paid, you are registered.
